Correspondent of Associated Press Visits Tubercular and Describes Devastation Wrought by British Raiders.

Tubercular, Ireland, Oct. 3.—(By the Associated Press.)—A town in half ruins and the remains of hundreds of houses in a street of a repetition of the raid of last week, and a handful of shivering nervous police who had shut themselves inside barracks with the body of the slain district inspector, Broady, to what respondent found when he reached this remote place in Ireland late today.

Reverent on Police

For many weeks the correspondent was told, the local police had been subjected to a series of raids on the town the people were declared to have been fired on from the roof of a large general store adjoining the barracks. The store later was riddled with bullets and its interior wrecked, the incident intensifying the feeling between the people and the police.

When the news on Thursday afternoon of the apprehension of a police party reached Tubercular, two-thirds of its 800 population fled in panic, anticipating a speedy reprisal. At about midnight four lorries filled with uniformed men and, it is said, including County Commissioner Russell, arrived in Tubercular, and the streets of the town were filled with the sound of rifle fire.

Accounts of what happened after the raid are given in the following paragraphs by various townspeople following the hurried stoppage in front of the public house and, with the exception of one young girl, on Commissioner Russell's order, all men answered the call of arms.
