Reimbursement for Cashing U. S. Army Postal Money Orders.

THIRD ASST. POSTMASTER GENERAL,
Washington, October 29, 1919.

Hereafter postmasters who desire to obtain reimbursement for cashing money orders issued by and drawn on United States Army postal service, must transmit them to the "Postal Agent, U. S. Army Postal Service, care of Second Assistant Postmaster General, Washington, D. C."

Inquiries regarding payment and complaints of nonpayment of orders drawn on the Army postal service in France or Germany should be addressed in the same manner. In view of the transfer to this city of the Army postal agency, all cases of the kind indicated will be adjusted at the headquarters here, where the records and files will be maintained.
